

Outreach Ambassadors

We want everyone in the community to know that our healthcare services are available to them! Our Outreach Ambassador team, comprised of staff members from many IWS departments, visit the health fairs, back-to-school events, and community events held by our many partners to spread the word about our services.

Care Coordinators

Many of our families need more than the preventive healthcare that we provide. Care Coordinators make connections between our patients and our partnering social service agencies for housing, food, specialty medical appointments, and much more. We are grateful for the collaborations that enable us to work with our patients to meet their needs.



Lurie Children's

Low-income children with developmental delays often do not receive the early intervention and treatment that they need to live their lives to the fullest. Lurie Children's partners with IWS to provide speech and occupational therapies through our unique CHAT program and give our patients the care they need.

Cradles to Crayons

Families will sometimes come to us in crisis. Lost jobs, unexpected illnesses, and many other situations can make our patient's lives even more difficult. Through our collaboration with Cradles to Crayons, Care Coordinators can provide necessary items to families in need. Families are thrilled and relieved to receive clothes, shoes, diapers, and other items that their children need to thrive.



Dental Training

Oral health care is overall health care. Students from the UIC College of Dentistry join IWS to provide dental care to children and their families. They also create lunchtime trainings for IWS staff to stay up-to-date on the best ways to care for our patient population.

El Valor

The earliest days of a child's life impact everything. Our partnership with El Valor and the Early Head Start program means that we can offer preventive services and meaningful educational opportunities to children ages 0-3.



ASSOCIATE BOARD

Associate Board members are young professionals passionate about children, families, and healthcare. They dedicate their free time to raising money and awareness for our mission.



The Back-to-School event entertains kids with games, crafts, and a bilingual musical entertainer and provides school supplies to IWS patients.

Back-to-School donors and volunteers gave away 75 backpacks to over 90 children and families in August 2018.

The Associate Board plan and launch a Signature Event, *A Fall Soiree*, that is held each fall as a fundraiser for IWS programs and services.

As suggested by this year's annual report theme, "Together for Tomorrow", we appreciate the partnerships the Auxiliary has cultivated over the years and how integral these have been to our success in providing a healthy tomorrow for the patients of the Angel Harvey Family Health Center. We believe the Auxiliary's accomplishments would not be possible without the pledge our members have made to work tirelessly together with their fellow chapter members, dedicated IWS staff, and our generous community partners.

The Auxiliary's fundraising efforts rely on the assistance of a wide variety of businesses in our chapters' individual communities. Our generous sponsors underwrite our events, provide valuable items for raffles and silent auctions, and extend discounts on everything from invitations to centerpieces to entertainment. They give us the opportunity to advertise our events in their stores and several sponsor 'Shop and Share' days and donate a percentage of that day's sales to the Auxiliary.

Neighborhood businesses provide space where our members collect used coats for our annual coat drive or sell Luminaria kits and organize bell-ringing for the December holidays. Additionally, local news publications feature our chapters and fundraising events with beautifully-written articles and photos to help tell our story.



AUXILIARY MESSAGE

In 2020 we mark the 10th anniversary of our annual coat drive and our relationship with one of our many remarkable partners. Each fall, CD One Price Cleaners promotes the collection of used coats and then cleans and delivers these items at no cost to us.

Meanwhile, chapter members collect donations of new coats, hats and gloves. Many Auxiliary Chapter members and clinic staff are involved in the event's setup and distribution. This year alone, we distributed 1100 coats of all sizes and hundreds of additional warm weather items to the clinic's families.

The personal connection we have with the clinic's patients continues to be one of the most rewarding aspects of our organization. Working with clinic staff, the Auxiliary has identified a wide range of patient-focused programs to help parents establish a healthy environment to benefit their children's' future.

Our chapters have fostered relationships with local groups who create beautiful handmade baby clothes, blankets and CHAT supplies. We have made literacy a top priority by financially supporting the 'Reach Out and Read' program, making book donations throughout the year, and including a book in each child's gift at our See Santa Party.

Our members work together to touch as many families' lives as possible by providing Mother's Day bags, bean soup kits, dental kits, baby clothes, diapers and formula.

We are immensely grateful to all of the community partners listed in the donations section of this annual report. Their generosity combined with the generosity of Auxiliary members empowers fulfillment of our ongoing mission to provide quality services to the families of the Angel Harvey Family Health Center.
