Family Nurse Practitioner

IWS Family Health, a community health center providing preventive health care services to children and families, seeks a Family Nurse Practitioner to work as a critical part of its Medical Team.

Position Responsibilities

- Provides well woman/preventative care (routine annual exams), acute care, management of contraception, management of gynecologic problems, management of chronic conditions, interpretation of diagnostic tests, and follow-up for all patients in the women's clinic.
- Participates in quality assurance assessments periodically (including abnormal pap management and mammography follow up)
- Coordinates Title X activities in the clinic; participates with other staff members to ensure all Title X requirements are adhered to and all Title X reports are completed in a timely manner
- Participates in Title X Family Planning audits and report preparation.
- Provides well childcare, acute care and follow-up, orders, interprets and performs laboratory and radiology tests for patients in the Pediatric clinic.
- Established diagnoses for common short-term and chronic stable health conditions.
- Reviews laboratory results, consultant examinations, and emergency room dispositions and follow-up on those requiring intervention.
- Prescribes medications as appropriate for patients. Supervises dispensing of medication from the women's clinic.
- Appropriately documents all findings concisely and completely utilizing the electronic medical records system. Uses all forms correctly. Entries dated and signed. Documentation must be legible
- Acts as a consultant for nurses and other staff members handling triage calls or walk-ins.
- Participates in specific programs as of the clinic as assigned by the medical director.
- Assists in education of patients and other staff

- Personality characteristics of patience, integrity, and approachability.
- Ability to speak Spanish is highly desirable but not required
