Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner

Position Responsibilities

- Works collaboratively with medical providers, social workers, and care coordinators.
- Conducts clinical/program consultation as scheduled
- Provides at least 1-2 evening clinic session per week and one Saturday a month
- Provides all psychiatric evaluations and treatment in strict accordance with approved methods and practices of the American Medical Association and the American Psychiatric Association
- Appropriately documents all findings concisely and completely utilizing the electronic medical records system. Uses all forms correctly. Entries dated and signed. Documentation must be legible
- Acts as a consultant for nurses and other staff members handling triage calls or walk-ins
- Participates in specific programs as of the clinic as assigned by the medical director
- Assists in education of patients and other staff
