Position Responsibilities

- Screen children and families who are referred externally or internally by clinic staff for social, emotional, developmental, or mental health problems
- Evaluate for appropriate psychotherapeutic and/or case management services as needed
- May also facilitate psychotherapy groups, both clinic-based and school-based, as needed.

- Must be an LCPC, LCSW or QMHP working towards licensure
- Two years' experience providing counseling and/or case management services to adults, children, and families
