



# FISCAL YEAR 2022 HIGHLIGHTS

## Expanding to Promote Health Equity

IWS Family Health is exploring opportunities to expand our integrated and coordinated healthcare home to better serve current patients and new patients. In addition to enhancing services at the Angel Harvey Family Health Center, such as offering an in-house pharmacy and nitrous oxide in dental, we are exploring cross-collaborative partnerships with organizations that have deep ties to additional communities identified as health professional shortage areas.



## Reaching Out: All Hands Health Network

We have joined the Lurie Children's All Hands Health Network (AHHN) program to help serve 42,000 children on Medicaid living in Chicago's under-resourced neighborhoods. As an AHHN partner, IWS Family Health will expand our reach and facilitate children's access to quality primary care, specialty care, and behavioral health services at our center.



## Patient Advisory Committee

We can only provide the highest quality care by receiving insight from our patients. IWS Family Health has a Patient Advisory Committee that meets quarterly to inform us of community needs and to discuss how we improve the patient experience. Programs like Child-centered Health and Advanced Therapies (CHAT) and enhancements like behavioral health in dental are the result of patient feedback.

## Community Collaboration

IWS Family Health participates in a variety of research projects to provide data that represents the BIPOC community and individuals living in low-income communities. Current studies include PANDA (Prevention of Asthma Exacerbation using Dupilumab in Urban children and Adolescents) with Lurie Children's and LINCC (Linking Inter-professional Newborn and Contraception Care) with University of Illinois and AllianceChicago.

## Health Center Quality Leader Badge

Health Center Quality Leader badges are awarded to FQHC Look-Alikes (LALs) that achieve the best overall clinical quality measure performance among all health centers nationwide. To receive a badge, health centers must meet or exceed national benchmarks across five clinical quality measure groups that promote behavioral health, heart health, diabetes health, HIV prevention and care, and maternal and child health. IWS Family Health was the only LAL in Illinois to receive the Quality Leader badge. There were only 10 badges granted to LALs nationwide.

# MESSAGE *from the* AUXILIARY

*Growth and Gratitude* aptly describe the experience and spirit that characterized the Auxiliary's Fiscal Year 2022, even though there were continuing economic and public health challenges. Although several major fundraising events in support of IWS Family Health had to be re-scheduled, when they ultimately were held, our Chapters received strong support from donors, members, and local communities.

**GROWTH.** Growth can be seen in the wide array of programs and services that the Auxiliary has been able to help fund through its contributions during this past year. And, that growth includes the 49 new Auxiliary members who brought their commitment, creativity, and resourcefulness to our organization and helped us achieve these results.

In addition to contributing \$425,000 to the IWS Family Health operating budget, the Auxiliary was able to fund additional medical and dental equipment to help IWS Family Health increase the menu of patient services it offers. This included: a new ECG machine on the medical floor to detect heart health issues; a vaccine freezer; a Cavitron with curing lights in the dental area; and a lead paint testing machine in the lab area.

The Auxiliary was especially pleased to be able to contribute another \$75,000 designated for the build-out of the third floor to increase behavioral health service capacity.

Other Auxiliary growth markers this past year included:

Launching a new six-month pilot project to provide 50 AngelBaby diaper bags for moms of newborns who are patients at IWS Family Health, which include key items that help babies stay healthy. Because the project was so well received by both new moms and medical staff, the Auxiliary was able to increase the number of AngelBaby diaper bags being provided in the new fiscal year to 100.

Increasing the number of **new**, warm winter coats distributed to Center patients during the Annual Coat Drive by 400 coats. This brought the total number of **new** coats donated to patients to more than 900.

Collecting enough food items to fill 143 Spring Food Boxes, each including a \$50 grocery gift card, that were distributed to patient families continuing to face food insecurity.

**GRATITUDE.** This past year the Auxiliary's contributions, through the collective work of its nine Chapters, helped make a difference in the lives of children and families who are IWS Family Health patients. The Auxiliary is deeply grateful for our members' participation, and extremely fortunate to have such talented and dedicated volunteers who support IWS Family Health. And, we are thankful for the generosity and support of our donors and local communities.

*Growth and Gratitude* were visible in everything that our members did and felt this past year. And, as Fiscal Year 2023 unfolds, we are prepared to make even greater strides in support of the wonderful cause that is IWS Family Health.


