Medical Assistant

IWS Family Health, a community health center providing preventive health care services to children and families, seeks a Medical Assistant (Bilingual English/Spanish) to work as a critical part of its Medical Team.

Position Responsibilities

- Interview patients, measures vital signs, such as temperature, blood pressure, weight, and height, and record information in patients' charts
- Stocks and prepares treatment rooms for examination of patients.
- Drapes patients with covering and positions instruments and equipment.
- Hands instruments and materials to doctor as directed
- Cleans and sterilizes instruments.
- Inventories and orders medical supplies and materials as assigned
- Gives injections or treatments and performs routine laboratory tests.
- Assist in Lab
- Administer vaccines
- Other duties assigned by provider.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Certificate from college or technical school as a Medical Assistant
- Certification preferred, not required
- Three to six months experience in pediatric clinic vaccine program is desirable.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) ability is required
- Problem solving; Identifies and resolves problems in a timely manner; gathers and analyzes information skillfully; develops alternative solutions; works well in group problem solving situations; uses reason even when dealing with emotional topics. Ability to work in a fast paced environment.
- Ability to multitask and prioritize duties.
